hen Professor Jeff McMahan <u>arrived in Oxford (https://www.telegraph.co.uk/universityof-of-oxford/)</u>, a chance conversation turned him off social media. A fellow philosophy lecturer was rueing the day he had agreed to be his grandson's "friend" on Facebook, then accepted requests from hordes of students. "I took that as a warning and never signed up," says McMahan.
